Scheduling & Fees

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Animals from rescues, humane societies, or animal controls must still be in the custody of the organization at the time of surgery. Owned/released animals cannot be scheduled in this clinic.
- With the exception of feral cats, animals scheduled must be safe to handle, healthy and, to the best of your knowledge, must not have bitten or scratched anyone in the past 10 days. Animals that our staff can't handle, are determined to be high risk due to illness, or kittens under 2 lbs. will not undergo surgery. In that event, 50% of the surgery fee will be charged to cover staff and lost surgery time (except feral cats).
- Kittens and puppies must be 8 weeks old or be of adequate weight for surgery--2 pounds for kittens, 5 pounds for pups.
- Pregnant animals will be spayed. Surgery will terminate the pregnancy.
- Spayed animals will be tattooed, and feral cats will also be ear-tipped on the left ear.
- Fax the completed Registration Form listing animals being sent for surgery, along with a Release Form and Pre-and Post-Surgery Instructions to vburo@clevelandapl.org or 216.771.2810 by noon on the day before surgery.

Dogs

- A maximum of 6 adult dogs can be scheduled per day (up to 4 spays).
- Dogs over 75 lb must be approved by the AWC before scheduling.

Feral and Homeless Cats

- Caregivers of feral or homeless cats do not have to show proof of 501(c)(3) status.
- Caregivers must register the cat(s)' or colony's location with the Cleveland APL.
- Feral cats will be ear-tipped (left ear).

SCHEDULE

Between 18 - 38 animals may be scheduled for surgery each day, depending on the mix of animals (fewer if there are several dog spays, and more if the schedule consists of mostly cats or male animals). Surgery appointments must be coordinated with the Cleveland APL's Spay/Neuter Services Supervisor.

Scheduling & Fees (cont.)

FEES

Nonprofit organizations and municipal agencies will be invoiced if needed. Feral cat caregivers must pay with cash or by credit card at the time of animal discharge.

Pediatric Dog (<10 lb)

Spay	\$35
Neuter	\$25

Adult Dog (10-45 lb)

Spay	\$50
Neuter	\$40

Adult Dog (45-75 lb)

Spay	\$65
Neuter	\$45

Adult Dog (>75 lb)

Spay	\$85
Neuter	\$65

Cat (Pediatric & Adult)

Spay	\$35
Neuter	\$25

Feral Cat/Kitten

\$40 (flat fee includes ear tip, FVRCP, rabies)

NOTES

- An additional of \$20 will be charged for complicated surgeries (i.e. cryptorchid, hernias, dogs over 95 lb, pregnant dog)
- Additional fees will be charged for any additional services, medications, or supplies recommended by our veterinarians
